CORRUGATED CARDBOARD is cardboard with a ribbed section between two heavy layers of cardboard. Flatten & bundle in pieces no larger than 3' X 3'. No food contaminated non-corrugated or wax coated cardboard. CEREAL or SODA BOXES place with Junk Mail.

such as cereal and soda boxes. Place in recycling container and keep dry.



YARDWASTE includes shrubbery or grass clippings placed in open containers weighing less than 30 lbs. Tree limbs or trimmings are to be **tied and bundled not exceeding 3' length or 1/2" diameter.**

*Landscaper Company yardwaste is to be taken, not left curbside.



LEAVES are to be raked to the curb. Place curbside any day to be collected with the vacuum leaf loader. Collection will be frequent during the leaf collection weeks. Please try to avoid parking which blocks access to leaf piles. Last day for leaf collection is November 29.
