82-1. Definitions. *amended 11-2003*

For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the meaning ascribed to them as follows:

LITTERING - Any item of unworded or carelessly discarded material, including but not limited to refuse, garbage, rubbish, trash, loose handbills, advertisements or other substance.

PERSON - Any person or persons, partnership, association, company, firm or corporation.

82-2. Littering public or private property. *amended 11-2003*

No person shall throw or in any manner deposit or suffer to be deposited any litter in or upon any street, sidewalk, park, body of water or other public or private property with the Borough.

82-3. Use of collection receptacles.

Persons depositing litter in public or private collection receptacles shall do so in a manner so as to prevent such litter from being carried by the elements onto any street, sidewalk or other public or private property.

LITTERING

82-4. Litter from vehicles.

- A. No person while in a vehicle shall throw or deposit or suffer to be deposited any litter upon any public or private property within the Borough.
- B. All vehicles used to transport loose materials shall be so constructed as to prevent the escape of such materials onto any public or private property.
- C. No vehicle shall be driven onto a public street while the tires thereof are likely to deposit mud or other foreign substances upon the street surface.

82-5. Litter on or from private property.

- A. No person while in a vehicle shall throw or deposit or suffer to be deposited any litter from private premises onto any public property.
- B. No person shall deposit any materials on any private property in such a manner as to allow or cause litter therefrom to be carried onto any other private or public property.
- C. All owners of private property are required to keep their property free of litter.

82-6. Violations and penalties.

- A. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and upon default in payment of the fine and costs, by imprisonment in the County jail for a term of not more than ninety (90) days.
- B. Each day that such violation exists shall be considered to be a separate violation.

ORDINANCE

AMENDING CHAPTER 82 PARAGRAPHS
82-1 AND 82-2, LITTERING

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Exeter Borough Official Ordinance Book at Chapter 82, Littering is hereby amended as follows.

82-1. Definitions: Littering shall include yard waste.

82-2 Definitions: Littering public or private property shall include streams or other bodies of water.

All other provisions of the of Chapter 82 Littering shall remain in full force and effect.


