ARTICLE III
Parking Regulations

134-13. Parking prohibited at all times.

- A. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:
- (1) On both sides of Schooley Street.
 - (2) On the westerly side of Wyoming Avenue from 1700 Wyoming Avenue to the Borough Line.
 - (3) On Stevens Lane within six hundred ten (610) feet of the intersection of Stevens Lane and Tunkhannock Avenue.
 - (4) The easterly side of Susquehanna Avenue between Schooley Avenue and Valley Street.
- B. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in designated fire lanes in the parking area of any shopping mall located in the Borough of Exeter.
- C. Parking shall be prohibited at all times within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station or, when properly sign posted, on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within seventy-five (75) feet of the entrance.
- D. Parking shall be prohibited from 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 4:00 o'clock p.m. on Monday through Friday on the easterly side of Memorial Street from Pennsylvania Avenue to Saint Anthony's Rectory.
- E. It shall be unlawful for any person to park, or to allow to remain parked, on any portion of Stevens Lane, any vehicle having a gross weight in excess of ten thousand (10,000) pounds or with more than two (2) axles.
- F. Parking shall be prohibited in any designated school zone from 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 4:00 o'clock p.m. on Monday through Friday.
- G. It shall be unlawful, and a violation of this Section, for any person to park in any reserved parking space, any vehicle unless that vehicle bears or displays either: a "handicapped registration plate", a "handicapped parking placard", a "disabled veteran registration plate", or a

"disabled veteran placard".

134-14. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined according to Section 6502 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code. It shall be the duty of the officers of the Borough to report to the Chief of Police all violations of any provisions of this Article, indicating in each case the section thereof violated, the license number of the vehicle involved in such violation, the location where such violation took place, the time of such violation and any other facts that might be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending such violation. The police officer making such report shall also attach to every such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this Article, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that if he shall report to the Municipal Building and pay, for the use of the Borough, the amount of said fine within forty-eight (48) hours after the time of such notice, the same shall save violator from prosecution before a District Justice including cost of prosecution and fine.




134-15. Violations and fines. AMENDED 12-2-08

The following motor vehicle violations and fines therefore are hereby established:

Rows include: Parked within intersection (\$10.00), Parking in crosswalk 20 feet from intersection (\$10.00), Parking or stopping left side to curb (\$10.00), Parking away from curb (\$10.00), Parking within 15 feet of fire hydrant (\$10.00), Parking in prohibited zone where designated by official signs (\$10.00), Parking in fire station zone (\$10.00), Parking in front of public or private driveway (\$10.00).
