134-14. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined according to Section 6502 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code. It shall be the duty of the officers of the Borough to report to the Chief of Police all violations of any provisions of this Article, indicating in each case the section thereof violated, the license number of the vehicle involved in such violation, the location where such violation took place, the time of such violation and any other facts that might be necessary in order to secure a clear understanding of the circumstances attending such violation. police officer making such report shall also attach to every such vehicle a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this Article, which notice shall contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that if he shall report to the Municipal Building and pay, for the use of the Borough, the amount of said fine within forty-eight (48) hours after the time of such notice, the same shall save violator from prosecution before a District Justice including cost of prosecution and fine.
