



Exeter Borough Garbage



Garbage is collected on Wednesday mornings.
There is a 3-bag limit 30 pounds max each.
Extra bag stickers are \$6.50 each

**Garbage: Place CURBSIDE
by 6:00 AM on Wednesday
(Tuesday Night recommended!)**

Trash must be in a garbage bag.

Do not use Exeter Borough recycling bins, grocery bags, or boxes!



- NO** drums, barrels, or other containers and will be assumed as trash if at the curb.
- NO** building materials, railroad ties, dirt, or rocks.
- NO** automotive parts, batteries, tires etc.
- NO** liquids, combustibles, or anything identified as hazardous. **NO** TV's.

BULK ITEMS accepted: Household furnishings, bicycles, stoves, microwaves, washers, dryers, etc.
Mattresses, couches, box springs, upholstered items **MUST** be wrapped in plastic. Carpets/rugs must be cut and bound in 3'- 4' sections. Maximum of 4 rolls. Refrigerators, A/C **MUST HAVE FREON REMOVED** and must be tagged by a professional freon removal service. **Bulk stickers are \$55.00 each.**



Pizza box BOTTOMS are trash. Pizza box tops, if clean, can be recycled.
Oils in cardboard will contaminate an entire recycling load!

GARBAGE DELAYS: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and weather issues. A **Code Red** alert will be sent to notify.

Exeter Borough Recycling



Recycling is collected Monday mornings.
There is a 4-can limit for yard waste.

Recycling: Place CURBSIDE by 6:00AM on Monday (Sunday night recommended!)

All recycling must be in the Exeter Borough recycling containers.

Recycling Items *ACCEPTED*

- *Aluminum and Glass-Beverage and Food Cans/Jars/Bottles- **Rinsed clean.**
- *Plastic Beverage/Food Bottles **(Plastic #1 and #2 ONLY)** -Rinsed clean
- *Newspaper, Magazine, Junk Mail & Office Paper – No shredded paper allowed.
- *Cardboard- flatten and condense. Separate cardboard from cans/co-mingled.
- ***NOTE: Recycling placed in plastic bags WILL NOT be picked up.**



- NO** styrofoam, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, paper towels/dishes, food, animal waste
- NO** appliances, electronics, wires, light bulbs, batteries, ceramics, dishes, mirrors, window glass
- NO** hazardous Material Containers, needles, syringes, metal
- NO** plastic #3, #4, #5, #6, #7
- NO** plastic bags of any kind. Return to local grocery stores.

Yard Waste *ACCEPTED* (Thursday APRIL 3,2025 to DECEMBER 4, 2025) NO EXCEPTIONS

- *Place grass clippings and shrubbery in open containers weighing no more than 30 pounds.
- ***DO NOT** put in bags.
- *Tree branches, limbs, trimmings; not to exceed 3' length or 1.5" diameter.
- *Tie and bundle or they **WILL NOT** be picked up



- NO** full trees accepted
- NO** yard waste from landscaping companies.

Yard waste: Place CURBSIDE by 6:00AM on Thursday (Wednesday night recommended!)

Leaves (NO collection Thursday November 27, 2025)

- *Last collection date December 4, 2025. **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**
- *Place leaves on tree lawn, sidewalks, or grass. **DO NOT** block sewer drains in the street.

Christmas Trees First three Thursdays in January 2,9, & 16, 2025.

Pickup exceptions: Collection will be on Tuesday for the following holidays:

Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, & Labor Day.

*Weather issues or short staffing may delay pickup.
