Exeter Borough to Hold Ribbon Cutting for the \$8M Wyoming Avenue-Schooley Avenue Sanitary and Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Exeter, PA - On Tuesday, February 17, 2026 at 1:00 P.M., the Borough of Exeter will hold a ribbon-cutting event to mark the start of the Wyoming Avenue-Schooley Avenue Sanitary and Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

The project provides for the replacement of aged and deteriorating sewer lines that separate the storm and sanitary sewer systems and reduces the risk of sewage backups, flooding, and environmental contamination.

The \$8M project represents collaboration at every level, a partnership of federal, state, and local leadership. "It has taken us years to assemble the financing, and we have a lot of people to thank," said Mayor Denise Adams.

Council Chairman Joseph Pizano explained, "This project provides for the future of our Borough, residents and businesses alike, and the underground infrastructure has to be done first before anything else."

The project has been made possible by \$969,000 of PA Department of Community & Economic Development LSA Grants and a \$6.9M USDA Rural Development loan. "We are also grateful to Peoples Security Bank & Trust for the interim financing," said Amy Huntington, Borough Manager.

John Morgan, Council Vice Chairman and Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority Board Member remarked, "We are thrilled to have finally broken ground after numerous supply chain delays and weather challenges. Now we have to remember, the traffic interruptions, parking challenges are temporary--this project is critical to replace the 100+ year old terracotta lines, and gives us safety and reliability in our sanitary sewer system for the next 100+ years to come."

The project will take 18 months to complete, and culminate with a long-awaited, newly-repaved Wyoming Avenue, rescheduled by PennDOT several times awaiting the sewer project completion.

The Wyoming Avenue-Schooley Avenue Sanitary and Storm Sewer Rehabilitation Project leads the way for future progress, including a proposed revitalized town center in the heart of the Borough. After updating the 2019 Exeter Borough Strategic Plan, goals include applying for a Pennsylvania Main Streets designation, which helps open up new funding opportunities for more improvements including new sidewalks, updated street lighting, and other town renovations.

The public is invited to attend the Tuesday February 17, 2026 Ribbon-Cutting Event and receive updates at the Borough Council's regular monthly meetings on the first Tuesday of the Month at 7:00 P.M. at the Borough Building, 1101 Wyoming Avenue, Exeter, PA 18643.
